

## Additional Information

1. The clay bund has been built from the playground area along to the Ward picnic area, approximately 250 metres.
2. The bund has been covered with topsoil and grass and has been established to help stabilize the sides with some planting carried out on the seaward side.
3. Posts and ropes have been installed to stop vehicles and bicycles driving on the bund as well as defining accessways at four points for beach access.
4. The purpose of the bund is to reduce flooding into the reserve during a high tide storm event, it will not stop erosion from occurring.
5. Staying out of the roped off areas will help the coastal edge to stabilize and allow plants to establish.



## How You Can Help

1. Walk to the beach by using one of the four beach accessways provided.
2. Keep the beach accessways clear for all to use.
3. Do not camp on the bund.
4. Please do not walk over the bund in the roped off areas.
5. Ask others, especially children, to respect the bund and use the accessways provided.

## Retention of Camp Sites

Established camp sites may only be left unoccupied for up to two consecutive nights per week. These nights will be charged at a minimum of two adults per night.

## Camp Fees

The overnight fee is \$6 per adult. Persons under 16 years of age, accompanied by an adult, are free of charge.

## Generator Use

Between 10 am to 3 pm only.

## Gate

The gate will be closed at 10 pm and opened at 7 am year round.

## Lights

Please turn off after use.

## Water

We buy all the water in this park (it is metered). It is safe to drink from the taps. No water bombs, water pistols etc. please.

## Pets

No pets or animals are permitted.

## Toilets

All Porta-Loos, buckets, tanks, kids potties etc. are to be emptied and rinsed at the dump station, NOT down the toilets.

## Fires

Small cooking fires only. For safety reasons, all fires must be in the BBQ 's provided, or on the sand below the high tide mark so the tide washes your fire away.

PLEASE use wood off the beach, NOT BUSH WOOD

## Liquor Ban

Between 7 pm to 7 am. No glass on the beach.

## Playground

Playground shuts at 10 pm. Flying fox is unlocked at 8.30 am

## Music

Music to be kept at a personal listening volume and turned off by 10 pm. After 10 pm to be talking noises only.

**Please share the taps, tables and BBQ 's and tidy up after use.**

### Coastcare Information

Storm events in recent years have de-established and eroded away the coastal edge, and many trees and shrubs have fallen into the sea.

Coastcare measures have been put in place to help lessen the effects of this erosion for reserve users and campers.

1. A clay bund has been built to reduce the chance of flooding into the reserve during a high tide storm event.
2. Beach accessways have been built.
3. Signage directing beach users to the accessways has been erected.
