

Submitter 1223 appears to be concerned that recent urban development is being favoured by the proposed rule amendments rather than safeguarding existing users and beneficiaries. From our perspective as a community water supplier, proposed rule 30.2.3.13 (b) (ii) is necessary to safeguard existing users who are already connected to our network. Prior to now, 30.2.3.13 overlooked the fact that there were customers living on rural zoned land that are connected to the rural extension part of our community water supplies. We acknowledge that there will have been some recent development within in these rural extension areas between April 2013 and July 2018 but it not possible to disconnect users once connected (refer Section 130 of the Local Government Act). We therefore consider that back dating the rule to April 2013, or prior, as suggested by submitted 1223 is not acceptable from our perspective.

Reasons for Support or Opposition:

The changes to rule 30.2.3.13 proposed in our original submission are necessary in a 'no dam' scenario to safeguard existing users, or users that Council has made a commitment to supply water to. From our perspective, the driver for including these rules is to avoid a regulatory clash between the TRMP, issued resource consents, approved special housing areas, and Section 130 of the Local Government Act.
