6.1 Consideration of 10 July 2019 Applications

Lani Evans, Community Partnerships Officer, summarised the report. She noted 16 applications were received totalling \$28,354.40 from a remaining available pool for this financial year of \$45,418.47.

The Subcommittee went through each application and made the following comments:

ArtHug Motueka

The amount of \$680 was granted.

Celtic Pipe Band Inc

The application was declined as it does not meet the funding criteria ie. applicants can't apply for equipment. The Subcommittee suggested the band applies to Rata Foundation and Department of Internal Affairs' Community Organisation Grants Scheme.

Golden Bay Community Arts Council

The amount of \$1,300 was granted.

The amount of \$350 was granted towards hall hire, promotion and administration hours.

The full amount of \$440 was granted.

Grant Knowles

The application was declined as the Subcommittee agreed that the application does not meet the funding criteria.

Mapua Art Group

The application was declined as the Subcommittee agreed that the application does not meet the funding criteria ie. can't apply for equipment. The Subcommittee suggested they apply to Rata Foundation and Department of Internal Affairs' Community Organisation Grants Scheme.

The full amount of \$1,975 was granted.

The full amount of \$325 was granted.

The amount of \$2,000 was granted. The Subcommittee suggested you work closely with the Nelson Provincial Museum regarding displaying and contributing towards the history boards,

using sustainable materials so they can be used again in the future and also apply to the Nelson Arts Council.

The amount of \$850 was granted. The Subcommittee suggested members pay a bit towards their personal coaching.

The amount of \$1,000 was granted.

Robert Fugah

The amount of \$1,400 was granted. The Subcommittee noted that it would be good if Mr Fugah brought the workshop to other parts of the Tasman region.
