These awards are an annual affair and they allow us to formally acknowledge individuals who have worked unselfishly on behalf of their communities in a variety of activities for twenty years or more.

So how do we find out about these wonderful people - through you. If you know of individuals or groups that you think deserve recognition for all their hard work, you can nominate them for an Outstanding Community Service Award.

Nominations

In May each year Tasman District Council calls for nominations from the public for the community awards.

Nominees must be residents of Tasman District to qualify. Nomination forms are available from all Council Service Centres and Libraries and give an outline of the type of information you need to include. Please use them when nominating someone for an award and be sure to post or deliver them to:

Nominations must be received by 31 August.

NOTE: We welcome additional information attached to the nomination form.

ALSO: Fire Service personnel must have 35 years' service to be eligible.

The selection process

After the closing date, a committee comprising the Mayor and other members of Council meet to evaluate the nominees and their contributions. Recipients of the awards are announced in October and all nominations are dealt with on a confidential basis.

The awards ceremony

The Community Award itself is a framed certificate and is presented at an official ceremony held in December. Friends and family of the recipients are also invited along to enjoy the occasion and partake in a light lunch with the Mayor following the presentation of the awards.
