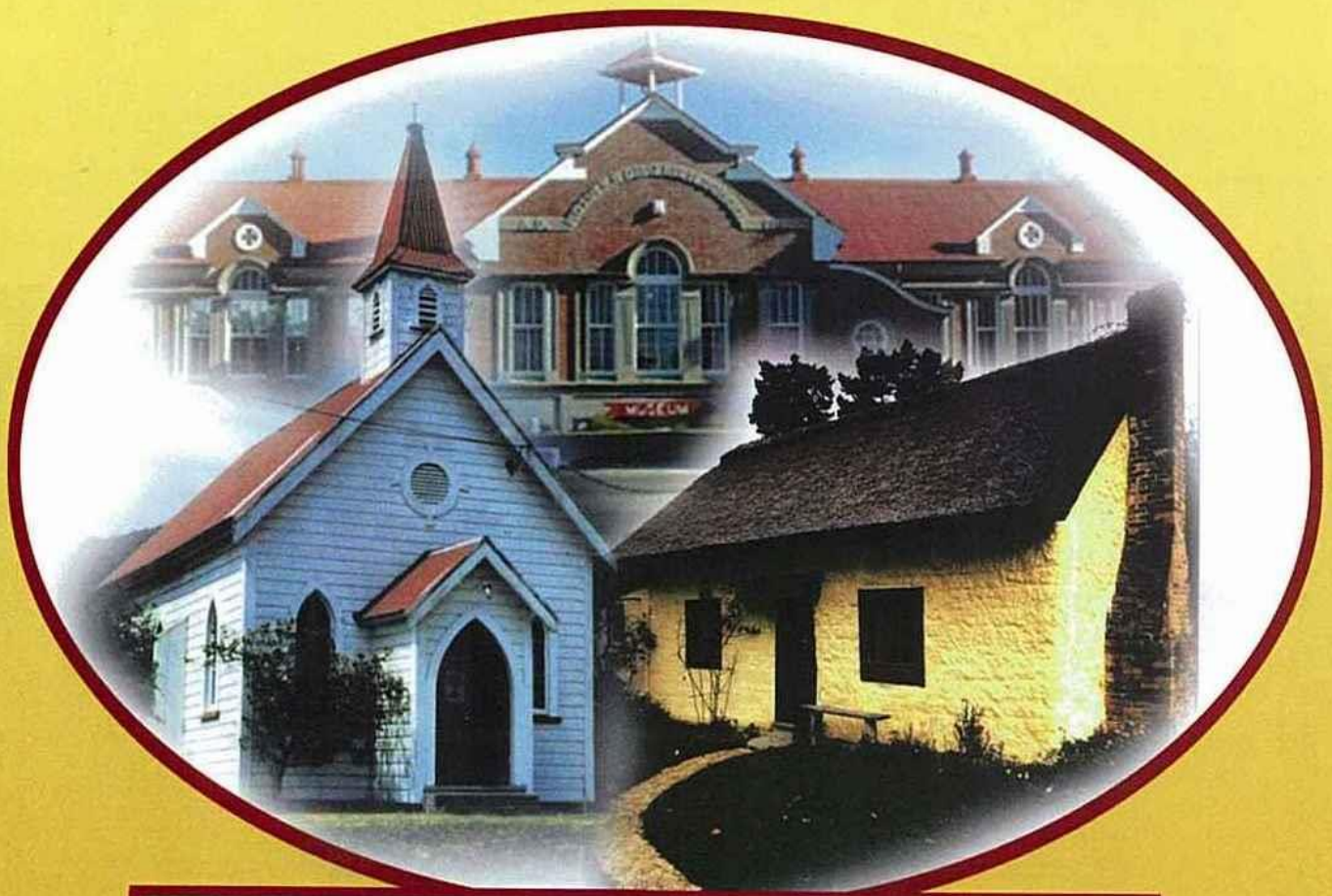


Heritage Building Restoration Initiatives

Introduction

The appearance and maintenance of heritage buildings and structures in the Tasman district is an indication of how highly heritage is regarded in the District. Well-maintained heritage buildings, structures and sites are a sign that the community cares about its heritage.

Heritage buildings are often more difficult to maintain than more recent buildings.

Initiatives for Repairs and Maintenance

To encourage repairs and maintenance of listed heritage buildings, the Council is promoting a range of initiatives.

The organisations below offer discounted rates for heritage buildings:

✦ **Resene Paints Ltd**

Tasman District Council Initiatives

Restoration work on buildings identified as having heritage value and listed in Schedule 16.13A of the Council's Tasman Resource Management Plan will be eligible to be considered for a financial contribution from the Council.

Options



If Repainting:

A contribution of \$200 towards repainting.

OR



If Repiling, Reroofing, Replacing Guttering or Earthquake Strengthening:

A contribution of up to \$500 towards repiling, reroofing, replacement or guttering, and up to \$500 for earthquake strengthening (for works less than \$100,000) or \$1000 (for works of \$100,000 or more).

To be considered to receive this funding, please complete the application form overleaf and post it to Council. Please apply before work begins and payment will be made on completion of approved work and provision of receipts.
